3. Owner signs permit and permission is formally granted to install drive pipe
4. Owner purchases required materials and completes all work necessary to install drive pipe as outlined on permit. Drive pipes must be perforated.
5. Owner notifies Township Road Superintendent for inspection during installation

1. Embed pipe in 3" or 4" of 304 gravel or limestone
2. There shall be no large stones, blocks, curbing or any other protruding obstruction, higher than the road surface at each end of the pipe.
3. Concrete driveway must end 36" from edge of road.
4. Asphalt driveway may go to edge of road, must be flush or below road surface.

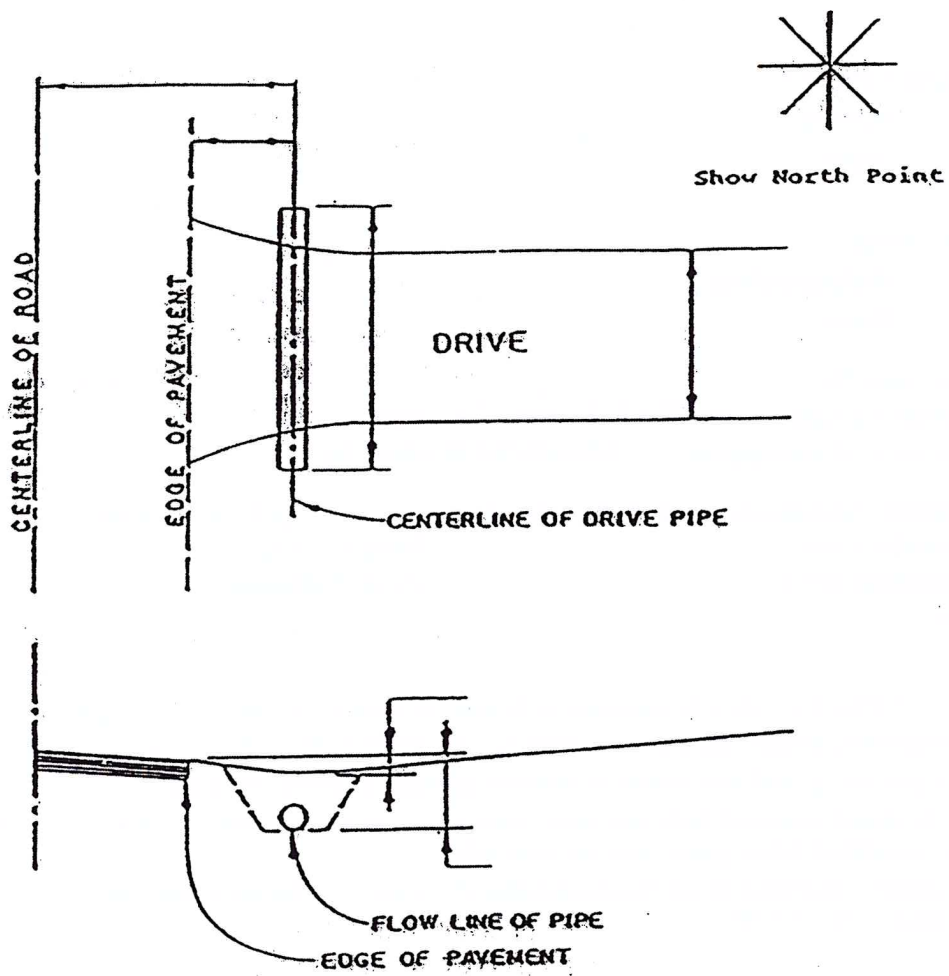
