

**Wayne County Resident Tire Collection Program:**

- 1) Residents may call the Wayne County Health Department on Tuesday, Thursday, or Friday at 330-264-2426 option 2 to schedule an appointment from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm to bring their tires.**
- 2) Passenger and light truck tires only.** No other tires will be accepted. Tires may be on or off the rim.
- 3) Residents are limited to 10 tires per person per year.** A driver's license is required.
- 4) Please pass this info on if you get calls that there is NO dumping of tires at the old location of Goodwill.** Tires illegally dumped can receive a fine of up to \$500 under R.C. 3767.32.

**ATTN TRUSTEES and City and Village Officials: STW Recycling District Government Tire Collection Program:**

For your Township, Village or City road crews that find tires dumped on public property or found along side of the road or in ditches we have a location for those tires to be properly disposed of now.

- 1) Please simply call the Wayne County Health Department at 330-264-2426 Option 2 to let us know the date and time and the number of tires you are bringing.**
- 2) The location is 1000 W. Liberty St, Wooster (Old bus garage location).**
- 3) The gate is open M-F 8AM-4:30PM.**
- 4) Do not place these tires in any bins on the property. These tires are to be stacked no more than 5 high in rows in the back right side of the property past the empty buildings near the fence. A red sign marking the approximate location will be on the fence.**
